## Must-Visit Historical Sites

- **Tulum Ruins** – Iconic **Mayan ruins on a cliff**, overlooking the Caribbean.
- **Coba Ruins** – Jungle-covered **Mayan city** with a climbable pyramid.
- **Chichen Itza** – One of the **New Seven Wonders of the World** (2-hour drive).
