- Tulum Ruins Iconic Mayan ruins on a cliff, overlooking the Caribbean.
- Coba Ruins Jungle-covered Mayan city with a climbable pyramid.
- Chichen Itza One of the New Seven Wonders of the World (2-hour drive).

- Gran Cenote Popular swimming & snorkeling spot with caves.
- **Dos Ojos** Stunning **underground cenote**, great for diving.
- Cenote Calavera Small, unique cenote with jumping platforms.

- Sian Ka'an Biosphere Reserve UNESCO-protected area with boat tours & wildlife spotting.
- Akumal Bay Snorkel with sea turtles in their natural habitat.
- Kaan Luum Lagoon Hidden turquoise lagoon with a deep cenote in the center.
